General Machine Maintenance for AM28, A5000, & Master J

Always refer to your operator's manual or contact Corghi USA service department for any technical questions.

General maintenance should be performed at least monthly or more frequently based on usage.

- Under NO circumstance is your machine to be pressure washed. To clean your machine, only use mild detergents sprayed directly onto a rag.
- Keep tabletop free of any debris
- Inspect air lines and gauges for kinks and cracks
- Ensure automatic oiler bowl is full and adjusted properly (Refer to operator's manual for proper procedure). Use non-detergent SAE20 air tool oil.
- Use WD40 or equivalent (DO NOT use white lithium grease) to lube the following: exposed cylinder shafts, horizontal MD head shaft, wheel lift guide shaft, and threaded screw oil pad
- Grease the following using an all-purpose shop grease: front and rear vertical guide rails, bead breaker vertical guide shaft, and the upper bead breaker locking handle. DO NOT grease the vertical screw shaft!
- Ensure Mount/Demount fingers are at the 6 & 12 o'clock positions when retracted.
- Check that the Mount/Demount to wheel distance is between 2mm and 4mm.
- Change MD head inserts when worn flat.
- Ensure proper vertical movement of the MD head by listening for the audible "click" of the brake when activating the head up and down.
- Check that the upper and lower rubber stops for the vertical MD head movement are not cracked.
- Check the bead breakers for excessive play up, down, left, and right. This play should be no more than 5mm at any time.
- Inspect white bead breaker rollers for gouges and cracks. The rollers should also spin freely.
- Inspect the lockdown pistol teeth for any chips or cracks.
- Inspect all cones for any cracks or gouges. CAUTION: Using a damaged component associated with the lockdown system may cause injury. Always inspect the pistol, cones, spacers, and any other components for damage prior to usage.

General Terms, Disclaimer & Limitation on Liability

Corghi USA expressly warrants its products will be free from defects in material and/or workmanship for the time period specified. Corghi USA must be informed in writing within 7 days after discovery of a defect. Corghi USA reserves the right to repair or replace a product at our discretion. Consumable products and accessories such as but not limited to; plastic protection parts, bead breaker pads, inflation hoses, and rollers, are not covered under this warranty. This warranty does not cover any damage resulting from abuse or failure to perform any necessary maintenance (i.e. damage due to or resulting from, faulty installation, neglect, misuse, improper electrical connections or electrical surges, problems resulting from excessive water, contaminated air system, or pollutant of any nature, fire or freight damage).
